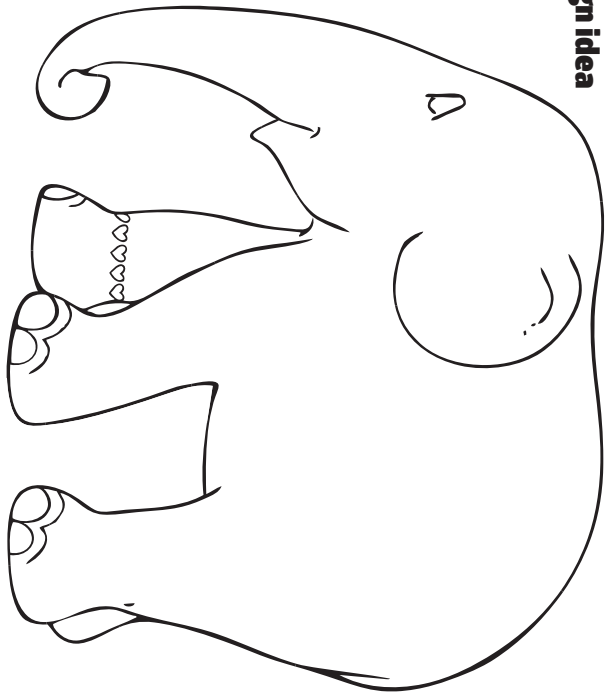

RULES AND GUIDELINES

- ▶ The competition is open to Year 1 to Year 10 students.
- ▶ Up to two entries per individual.
- ▶ Artworks must be submitted with a completed entry form.
- ▶ Artworks must be original. No copying please!
- ▶ Each entry should be certified by a parent, guardian or teacher as an original, unaided piece of work produced during the last 12 months.
- ▶ All entries must be accompanied with a passport-sized photograph and photocopy of school ID.
- ▶ No entries will be returned.
- ▶ We will only accept originals. Photocopies or scanned images will not be considered.

JUDGING

Judging decisions will be made by the creative teams of Elephant Parade and the Singapore Yacht Show. Selected entries will be displayed on the Elephant Parade Exhibition Stand during the Show and will be posted on the Official SYS website.

PRIZES

1ST place winners will receive a 75cm blank Elephant Parade model and a DIY Artbox. 2ND place winners will receive a 30cm model and DIY Artbox and 3RD place-winners a 15cm model and DIY Artbox. Selected other entries will receive a 15cm painted model of their choice.
